New Look For Township Police Department

The next time you see an Upper Providence Township Police Officer on patrol, you may notice something new about their uniforms. That is because for the first time in more than 35 years the Upper Providence Township Police Department is wearing brand new uniforms featuring an updated police patch design. “The new uniforms provide our officers with a progressive and professional look,” says Police Chief Mark A. Toomey.

Since being sworn in as the new Police Chief on September 3, 2013, Chief Toomey has not only been working on improving the internal operations and training of the Upper Providence Township Police Department, but he’s also been working on updating the outward expressions via working with his department and a designer to create a refreshed police patch design and uniform. An air force blue uniform shirt and dark navy blue pants with a complimentary blue stripe was designed. Additionally, the more traditional style campaign hats have been replaced with a city style “crushed look” hat. To date, 23 officers have been issued new uniforms and all future officers added to the force will receive the same.

Chief Toomey has also promoted two sergeants and four corporals and created an administrative sergeants position to establish an appropriate command structure within the department since starting his appointment.

An Update for Patrol Vehicles, Too

Uniforms aren’t the only Upper Providence Township Police Department items that received an update—patrol cars are being redesigned to amplify the “Upper Providence Township” name. In the new design Upper Providence is spelled out in large letters with

a traditional black and white paint scheme accented with an enlarged decal of the updated police patch attached to the front fender.

Three new police vehicles display the new paint and logo scheme and a slow transition of existing vehicles will occur over the course of the next year.

Creating a Sense of Pride

The officers of the police department are very enthused with the new look in both the uniforms and car design. “The new uniforms have provided the officers with a sense of pride in how they look,” says Chief Toomey.

The Upper Providence Township Police Department serves Oaks and Mont Clare as well as areas of Collegeville, Royersford, and Phoenixville. ♦

New Building In Police Department’s Future

Plans are moving forward to build a new Upper Providence Township Police Building to support the growing Township police department. By the end of the year, the police department will have grown to 28 officers, and the current building does not adequately support a department of this size. The police department consisted of 11 officers when the existing police building was first occupied.

Additional plans for the new building include constructing meeting and training rooms to provide a space to be able to meet and schedule time with members of the Upper Providence Township community who need police services.

New Building For Police Department

“The new building will provide appropriate accommodations for all aspects of the police function with the design to facilitate the operations of administration, patrol, and investigations,” says Chief Toomey.

Although a formal construction schedule has not been yet determined, the Township anticipates construction will start prior to the fall, and will be completed in approximately one year.

The new building will also allow the police department to move forward with the state accreditation process as established by the Police Chiefs Association of PA. Accreditation will adjust and improve existing police department policies in line with state standards. The police department has a goal of joining the more than 80 other police agencies in Pennsylvania that are accredited.

Plans in Final Review

Residential:

- **Bechtel Road**, just west of Route 113. A proposal to create seven lots, by Robert Fieo.
- **750 Black Rock Road**. Desimone proposes a three-lot residential sub-division.
- **1045 Black Rock Road**. Toll/Troutman proposes 97 units to be developed on 55 acres under the new Township Mixed Residential Community zoning district.
- **Campus Drive**. Providence Corporate Center/Madison prose to develop 304 luxury apartments across from the Marriott.

Commercial:

- **Campus Drive, between Troutman Road and Route 29**. The Berwind Group plans three additional buildings on 289,300 sq. feet. This project was the subject of a recent zoning change to allow apartment use.
- **Egypt Road**, south side, just west of Hollow Road. Gambone Brothers proposes nine flex buildings located on a 42-acre tract.
- **1501 Main Street**. A proposal to create a 50,000 square foot indoor recreation facility for youth soccer leagues.
- **541 Hollow Road**. Pitt/Ohio proposes to use the existing trucking terminal to expand the parking area and the paved sources around the terminal building.

Plans Requesting Preliminary Review

- **628 Black Rock Road**. Bard Property proposes a three lot sub-division.
- Olympic Road, west side. A proposal to sub-divide the property into eight lots for the construction of single family homes.
- **1095 Black Rock Road**. This project by Freeland/Curry on 15.22 acres proposes 52 units to be developed under the new Township Mixed Residential Community zoning district.
- **1112 Collegeville Road**. Morgan Tract/Gambone proposes 89 units to be developed under the new Township Mixed Residential Community Zoning district. It is located on 24.15 acres.
- **1425 Collegeville Road**. Emeritus at Collegeville/Wegmans proposes a 241 unit assisted living and nursing home. Tract size 9.84 acres.
- **Lower Perkiomen Valley Park**. The County has requested a land development review of a proposed 9,600 SF maintenance garage/office located on the 51-acre park that they own in this location.

Plans Requesting Tentative Approval

- **New Mill Road Adjacent to the Lower Perkiomen Valley Park**. Oaks Properties Inc. proposes the use of outside storage for a four acre property.
- **Hollow Road Across from Schell Lane**. The project proposes the subdivision and 20.6 acres and the erection of a 188,140 square foot storage facility.
- **Providence Town Center at 200 Spring House Road**. The applicant proposes a two building land development. One building is flex office space and the other building is proposed as a daycare center.

Zoning Proposals

The following locations are under consideration by the Board of Supervisors as of April 2014:

- **Ridgewood Partnership**. The developer has requested a change of zoning and a text amendment for the property on Linfield Trappe Road between Pennapacker and Kline Road.
- **615 Hollow Road**. A proposal to a change of zoning to R-3 Residential to allow the construction of 49 town homes located at the corner of Egypt and Hollow Roads.
- **Campus Drive & 422**. The applicant has requested a conditional use review of a proposed Billboard to be installed along 422 near the Marriott current location.


