

Township Notice - Hurricane Ida

In the aftermath of Hurricane Ida Upper Providence Township applied for and received approximately \$19,000,000 in Federal funding to acquire flood-prone homes located along the Perkiomen Creek and the Schuylkill River. Most of the homes are located in Mont Clare and the Village of Port Providence.

The Board of Supervisors recently awarded a publicly bid project to demolish twenty-two of the acquired homes to G & R Excavation and Demolition.

We acknowledge the temporary disruption and inconvenience that the demolition project may cause and we appreciate the residents' consideration while the work is completed.






Online Applications and Payments Coming Soon!

Congratulations to Sergeant Eric Smith for celebrating 20 years of dedicated service with the Upper Providence Township Police Department!



The Upper Providence Township Police welcomed a new furry friend recently. Argo is a 1-1/2 year old black lab who will be handled by Cpl. Jason Gerhart (a 15 year veteran of the Police Department). In between agility training and hanging with the Police Department, Argo will be utilized for evidence recovery, tracking and narcotics.

The pup was trained for Scent Detection at the Penn Vet Working Dog Center. Argo is not trained for apprehension (he is not trained to bite) and is a playful but well-behaved pup when not working. Fire and Emergency Services

Live Burn Training

On Monday, June 3rd our firefighters went to the Montgomery County Fire Academy in Conshohocken to participate in a live burn training with some of our mutual aid partners; Perkiomen Township Fire Company, Royersford Fire Department, Black Rock Volunteer Fire Co. and Trappe Fire Company No. 1.

The mixed teams worked multiple scenarios and evolutions in a supervised structure burn training. Teams focused on hose deployment and advancement plus search & rescue techniques, RIT (Rapid Intervention Team) and general firefighting. It's a best practice to train together with our volunteer and mutual aid partners. Thanks to the Montgomery County Fire Academy for the use of their training facility. Our firefighters are required to participate in at least one live burn event each year. Constant and consistent training and discussion plus going through some practical scenarios keep all of us ready to respond.

Emergency Services News

During emergencies and disasters, township employees from all departments come together to work in the Emergency Operations Center (EOC), which coordinates emergency response and recovery. EOC team members participated in three training sessions to enhance and practice their emergency management skills focusing on the Incident Command System, National Incident Management System, and EOC Operations.

The training culminated in a FEMA-led virtual tabletop exercise with six other EOC's nationwide focusing on a dam failure. Over 30 employees participated in 180 hours of training in the months of May and June!

Recently Engine 68 (C Platoon) went across the street to Black Rock Park for "Walk with a Firefighter" which turned into "Playground Fun with a Firefighter".
